SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Yes, I do concur with the amendment. I think it helps the bill and would ask for its approval.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Senator Beutler, you're recognized to close. Senator Beutler waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM0800 to LB 213. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. I move the advancement of LB 213 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the advancement of LB 213 to E & R for engrossing. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.
