SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, and Senator Cudaback, I'd like to say two or three words on Senator Cudaback's bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the bill? Senator Cudaback, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR CUDABACK: I think I know when I'm well off.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: He's waived the closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 92. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 92.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. We next move to LB 92A.

CLERK: LB 92A, by Senator Cudaback. (Read title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Cudaback, you're recognized to open on the A bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, members, I thank the body for that vote. It shows that the important things in life do count. And this is simply an A bill that goes along with...goes along with that bill, to supply the dollars for it. Unfortunately, we have to do this and it's \$177,000 for the...each...each year, starting 2001-2002, 2002-2003. And you all understand that and that's...that's the A bill that goes along with LB 92.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the bill? Senator Wehrbein. Waives. Senator Cudaback, you're recognized to close on the advancement of the bill. He waives that opportunity. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 92A. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 92A.
