PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the fifty-fourth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain of the day is Father Paul Witt, from St. Mary's Catholic Church in...here in Lincoln, who is in Senator Beutler's district. Father Witt.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Father Witt. We will call the Nebraska Legislature to order. Members, please record your presence. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the journal?

CLERK: No corrections this morning, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Any reports, announcements, or messages?
