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SENATOR BEUTLER: I noticed in the bill that you obviously have made the effort to disengage the Lieutenant Governor from the Accountability and Disclosure Commission and the Candidate Committee and some of that. I was kind of surprised that it appeared to be so easy to do. Let me ask you one question. And I could...my memory could be wrong on this. But financial disclosure forms, I know that I as an incumbent have to file them. I think candidates have to file them. Do they not?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes. Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Unless I missed it in the bill, I think maybe you need to go back and disengage...or, redo the time lines or something. Let me ask you what your intent would be. Would your intent be that the candidate for Lieutenant Governor should continue to file a financial disclosure form?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, it would be my intent.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Then I think there some...needs to be some adjustment on the dates or deadlines, given the changes you've made in the bill.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, we'll take a look at that. And if...and I'll talk to Senator Schimek, and if we need to make some adjustments there, we can do that on Select File.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Sure. Let me just ask you this, generally. Did Accountability and Disclosure have the opportunity to look at the bill, generally, for changes that might be necessary?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Beutler, I did not engage them in this bill. And that was probably an omission on my part that should not have taken place.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah. Well, it...I really like the way you've
