CLERK: Yes, sir. May I read some items, Mr. President? Mr. President, before we proceed, new A bills: LB 580A by Senator Tyson. (Read by title for the first time.) LB 440A by Senator Byars. (Read by title for the first time.) LB 399A by Senator Cunningham. (Read by title for the first time.) And LB 22A by Senator Suttle. (Read by title for the first time.) Senator Bromm, an amendment to LB 827 to be printed. (Legislative Journal page 1270.)

Mr. President, LB 671, on General File, originally introduced by the General Affairs Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16, referred to the General Affairs Committee. The bill was advanced to General File.
