I was pleased when I got to North High School because the parking lot was filled with vehicles, and when I went into the auditorium where it was to be conducted, it might have been the gym, full of people. So I felt this was going to be a good meetings. Then all of a sudden the room began to empty and I wondered what had happened. So I saw a black man who is working for the school system, I won't tell you the capacity. I said, "Man, what's going on here?" He said, "Ernie, you see all those people leaving?" I said, "Yeah". He said, "Those are teachers, counselors and administrators who were told to come here and pack the audience, but since there are so few parents, the administration, and Mackiel was there, told them to all leave because if these people from the Department of Education see all of these teachers, counselors and administrators and very few parents, they will begin to see what the schools have been doing, so those teachers were ordered to leave, and they left." And I mentioned that during our conversation with this lady. That meeting was totally unsuccessful, it was totally unacceptable. So the complaining parent contacted the people at the regional office of the Department of Education and another meeting was to be arranged and the schools were to notify the parents. That's when the schools intervened and contacted the Department of Education people and told them, we don't want this meeting at this time. And here's where a local school system that had been complained against was able to prevail on the agency that was to hear the complaint not to have the meeting. That's the way they play, and they can get away with it with parents. If a parent is very concerned about his or her children, that parent is deemed pushy and a troublemaker. They call the police on parents because the parent wants an answer and says, I don't want to leave until I get it. Then the PTA and these other Negroes hand-picked to do these dog and pony shows will complain about the absence of interest by black parents and the education of their children. When I used to go to these schools frequently, nobody would tell me not to come in because they were physically afraid of me, but it should not be that kind of a relationship. Every parent who shows an interest in his or her child should feel free to come to those schools. And what they do is give...
