SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...are asking the government to conduct police checks on those who are priests and working in the church because of the wrongful conduct. And here's where they're smarter than the people in this country. They recognize that those who violate the rules of the church are not church members and they don't want them there. In this country they protect them and they move them to different dioceses and don't tell the people. As a result, you have these priests who committed these violations here, there, or there and have a trail all the way across the country, and the church is now losing huge judgments because it's becoming a matter that the courts are almost taking judicial notice of that the church hierarchy protects these priests who violate young people. But we don't have anybody other than me who is willing to stand on this floor and defend the public treasury from pillaging by the religious outfits.
