groups and the chemical supplier groups. And after talking to Senator Wehrbein and other members of the Legislature, we have included an A bill of \$250,000. I know under tight budget constraints that sounds like a lot of money now, but certainly Senator Wehrbein was on board at that time and supporting. He did not commit the committee, the Appropriations Committee, but he told me he would be supportive. I don't see him this morning and that's okay. This will have a thorough discussion on Select File, but this is the bill that needs to follow. It's \$250,000 for clean water.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Open for discussion on the advancement of LB 329A. Seeing no lights on, Senator Schrock, did you wish to close? Senator Schrock waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 329A advance? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 329A. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 329A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The bill does advance. Select File.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 827A. Senator Erdman, I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. I move the advancement of LB 827A to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion is to advance LB 827A to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, next, General File.
