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that. My intent is to strike from the bill the Sutherland Plant. Before Senator Dierks' amendment was adopted, which went to page 3 of the committee amendment and struck lines 7 through 27, my amendment would have achieved that purpose. But because his amendment struck that language and put in other language, my amendment as drafted will not work. Now I would like to ask Senator Dierks a question, if he has his material.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: I'm not sure I have, but I'll try.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Dierks, any amendment that...you had an amendment that struck language from the committee amendment found on page 3, starting in line 7, I believe.

SENATOR DIERKS: Section 4 and 5?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes. So any amendment that was drafted to that language as it existed in the committee amendment probably would not fit without some modification with the amendment that we adopted of yours. Would you agree with that?

SENATOR DIERKS: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Because of that, Mr. President, I'm not going to carry us through a discussion of this amendment, even though I could talk about its purpose. Should I be able to persuade people to adopt it, it would be ineffectual because it does not go to the right portion of the bill, so I want to withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: So ordered, it is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item to the committee amendments.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, next amendment is offered by Senator Chambers. This is FA196.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on FA196.
