ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1676.) The vote is 2 ayes, 36 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The Chambers amendment is not adopted. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, priority motion. Senator Dierks would move to invoke cloture, pursuant to Rule 7, Section 10.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is...Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. Speaker, is the house still under call?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The house is under call. Would you like all members to check in?

SENATOR DIERKS: If you please.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Mr. Clerk, would you clear the board. Members, please check in. Senator Price, would you check in, please. Thank you. All members are present. The first motion is, shall cloture be invoked? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. There's been a request, by Senator Chambers, for a record vote. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1677.) The vote is 39 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to invoke cloture, Mr. President.
