SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...some of this came in after I think their main budget was put together, at least the urgency of it. The UNO Engineering Building renovations has been on, that it's the number one priority of the University of Nebraska System. It's been on that list for quite awhile and so it's its turn, so to speak, as I said, because it's the number one priority. The Wayne State College Power Plant the Governor did also. Once again, that is nearing a point of crisis in terms of doing something about it. And Kearney YRTC was a bill. The Governor did not recommend this but there...I think there's large concern among the committee and broader that we need to do some things at Kearney. So this is our recommendations at this point and I will be glad to try to answer questions. If you want even more detail,...
