SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. Items for the record? Excuse me, before items to the record, LB 666A. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 666A by Senator Wehrbein. (Read title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on the A bill.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, this simply carries out the intentions of LB 666. It's \$1,593,125 each year. Once again, that's the depreciation that we're setting aside for repair and maintenance into the future.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on advancement of the bill? Seeing none, Senator Wehrbein waives closing. Question is the advancement of LB 666A. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 666A.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Bill advances. Mr. Clerk, I'm sorry, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. LR 66 by Senator Hilgert. That will be laid over, Mr. President. And Senator Chambers has amendments to LB 543 to be printed. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1678-1681.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Senator Connealy.

SENATOR CONNEALY: I'd move that we adjourn till Thursday at 9:00 a.m.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Heard the motion. The question before the body is, shall we adjourn? All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. We're adjourned.
