of circumstances. And since you feel it's just and fitting and proper for our children, it's got to be just and fitting and proper for yours too. So when these white people come to me with complaints about maybe hurting the children by what I'm doing, I'm not hurting...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...black children, Latino children, poor white children; they're being hurt right now. The children they're concerned about are the better children--their children. And until theirs can feel some of the pinch, they're not interested in putting better shoes on the feet of anybody. So I've got my work cut out for me. I intend to do it. So you can glance through that sheet, I mean that handout, and if you look at the last page you will see where Omaha, last year, got \$5 million in federal funds for a special teaching program. If these teachers major or do work in math and science, finish the course at UNO, they get a special certificate, and \$1,800 as a bonus. Senator Raikes told you there are federal programs available. You will see from that last sheet that Omaha, last year, got \$5 million from such a program, and it has not been talked about on the floor. There are a lot of things I've got to talk about, but I'll proceed as the afternoon unfolds.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate? Senator Chambers, you've already spoken three times on this particular amendment. You are recognized to close.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, we're moving right along here. And I don't think I'm going to withdraw this amendment and file it again.
