PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the seventy-fifth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, First Session. Our prayer this morning will be from Senator Kruse.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Any messages, reports or announcements this morning?

CLERK: Mr. President, the bills read on Final Reading last evening were presented to the Governor at 7:15 p.m. (LB 489, LB 711, LB 797). Communication from the Governor to the Clerk. (Read re LB 711). And, Mr. President, report of registered lobbyists for this week. And that's all that I have at this time.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Members, we'll begin today's agenda. First item is General File, 2001 priority bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 305, a bill introduced by Education Committee and signed by its membership. (Read title.) The bill was discussed yesterday, Mr. President.
