LR 64, 65, 66

propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 64, LR 65 and LR 66. We next move to General File, LB 536A. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 536A, introduced by Senator Dierks. (Read title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Dierks, you're recognized to open on the A bill.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature. LB 536A simply implements the transfers from the General Fund to the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund, called for by the underlying bill as it was amended by the Revenue Committee amendments. The bill currently requires a transfer of \$3 million in each year of the next biennium and states legislative intent to appropriate \$3 million through FY 2007-2008. I would respectfully request your advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the advancement of the bill? Seeing none, Senator Dierks, you're recognized to close. He waives the closing. The question is the advancement of the bill? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 536A.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. We next move to LB 659A.

CLERK: LB 659A, Mr. President, by Senator Chambers. (Read title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on the A bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, LB 659A is the funding bill for LB 659, which deals with DNA. I have worked with the person who represents indigent defendants under that county program that we put together. They
