**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Senator Coordsen, you're recognized to close on your amendment.

**SENATOR COORDSEN:** Only briefly. I was thinking, as other people spoke, that when I began this legislative effort some years ago I had 16 K-12 schools in my system and, until this program was put into place, I had 16 K-12 schools in my district, and now there are 12 and others talking. So I think that indicates a little bit what Senator Stuhr mentioned, that it has been a program that has worked very well. But I think that the people who are interesting in availing themselves of this, and many on the list I don't think will...will tie themselves to an agreement that quickly, will get the job done and moving on. So I would...would encourage the adoption of this amendment to LB 313.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

**CLERK:** 28 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Select File amendment is adopted. Senator Erdman.

**SENATOR ERDMAN:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I move the advancement of LB 313 to E & R for engrossing.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** You've heard the motion. The question before the body is advancement. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It is advanced. We next move to LB 313A.
