PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the seventy-eighth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain this morning is Senator George Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Members, we'll call the Legislature to session. Please record your presence. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Any messages reports or announcements?

CLERK: Senator Erdman, I have no amendments to LB 667A, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. I move the advancement of LB 667A to E & R for engrossing.
