LB 620

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is, shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Would unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Would members please return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The roll call vote in regular order, please.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Regular order on the roll call has been requested. The house is under call. The house is under call. Senator Schimek, Senator Byars, the house is under call. Question before you is the adoption of AM1877 by Senator Wickersham to LB 620. Those in...or, excuse me, we do have a roll call vote in regular order. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1894-1895.) 11 ayes, 30 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is not adopted. The call is raised. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the last amendment I have, Senator Beutler, but I have a note you wanted to withdraw, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Beutler. The amendment is withdrawn.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, withdraw.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Debate on the advancement of LB 620.
