SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...but those are the kind of people who are supporting ethanol so what should I expect, a pound of intelligence...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...from an ounce of brains? Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator. Senator Hartnett, on the first part of the divided question. Senator Cunningham.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I could have asked Senator Schrock, but I'm going to ask you because you brought it. You...you referred to the sheet that Senator Schrock passed out dealing with Kansas, South Dakota, Missouri, Iowa and, yeah, South Dakota is twice.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: You said that the...I think you said the production in these states has led to the development of plants. And I got...I'm real curious of, you know, how many new plants...can you give me, because we're going to move off this at 4:00, but you'll have some time, before this come up again. But how many plants and what's the age of the plants in these, like, Kansas, in the states that you have, Senator Schrock, you have listed there. That's what I...that's the information I'd like to get is to...because I think what you're...what you were saying was that this subsidies in these other states, we got to keep up with them, and someone suggested we want to keep up with California and their electrical energy. I don't think we do but...but how is these subsidies works in these other states, I guess that's my question and you can...if you would get that information to me when we debate this bill again, I would really appreciate that at this...

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Okay. I'll get that for you, Senator.
