

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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FLOOR DEBATE

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LB 465, 536, 667A
LR 122, 123, 124

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's going to be a symbol and a monument to the foolishness of the members of the Nebraska Legislature and the waste of all that General Fund money squandered, and nobody can counter what I'm saying and I wish they would try because I would immediately get up after they get through, on my next turn, and I would cut them down to their shoelaces. I'll show they don't know what they're talking about or they are fibbing, so they dare not make the challenge. And I've got information I haven't even used yet. I'm waiting for them to stand and challenge but they won't. I'm able to deal with them out of the information I take out of my watch pocket, that I take off the top of my head. They cannot meet anything we're saying with facts. They make an emotional appeal, we are farmers here and we want to sell our product. Well, we have a cheap food product...policy, give us some money. Those are not facts. When we come back to this bill, brothers and sisters,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...be ready because I certainly shall be.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. It is 4:00 and as the agenda states, General File 2001 committee priority bills. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record first?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have items. Thank you. Study Resolutions: LR 122 by Senator Foley, LR 123 by Senator Vrtiska, LR 124 by the General Affairs Committee; all will be referred to the Executive Board, Mr. President. I have a confirmation report from Health and Human Services signed by Senator Jensen as chair of the committee. Mr. President, Senator Coordsen, amendment to LB 536 to be printed; Senator Wehrbein to LB 536; and Enrollment and Review reports LB 667A as correctly engrossed. Mr. President, LB 465 on General File, a bill originally introduced by Senator Wickersham. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10 of this year, referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President.
