PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Raikes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Raikes, did you say she's replacing John D. Rockefeller?

SENATOR RAIKES: I maybe did, but actually it's John D. Feller.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, thank you. I stand corrected.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion? Senator Raikes, you're recognized to close. Senator Raikes waives closing. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report of the Education Committee. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal pages 1921-1922.) 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Confirmation report is agreed to. (Doctor of the day and visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk, General File.

CLERK: Mr. President, A bill this morning, LB 305A by Senator Raikes. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Raikes, you're recognized to open on LB 305A.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members. LB 305A is the A bill accompanying LB 305, the Education Committee's bill to address teachers' salaries. I'm not...well, I'll...I'll mention quickly that the bill corresponds very closely to the discussion we had on General File. I would encourage you to take a look at the fiscal note. I think it's a very complete description of what...of not only the programs that are a part of LB 305 but the costs associated with them. It, of course, includes both the appropriations for those programs and the sales tax revenues intended to provide or to
