SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good afternoon and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Members, please check in so we can begin this afternoon's proceedings. Roll call. Record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, just one item. Senator Raikes would like to print an amendment to LB 305. (Legislative Journal page 1985-1986.) That's the only item that I have.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (Visitors introduced.) We next move to General File, the redistricting bills by special order. Mr. Clerk, LB 852.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 852, the bill was introduced by the Redistricting Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on April 26 of this year, referred to General File. After a public hearing by the Redistricting Committee, I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM1875, Legislative Journal page 1916.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Coordsen, you're recognized to introduce the committee amendments.
