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LB 536A, 536

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...the short answer is. I don't see a reason. Their A bill says \$3 million at this time. That's what the bill is at this time, the green copy, so they match.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But don't you think there would be other discussion than just that which would surround this \$3 million figure that's in the A bill?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes. I assume so, but that...but, frankly, the A bill is only going to carry the General Fund \$3 million.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But if there were these other discussions, it would draw in the underlying bill, LB 536, wouldn't it? And at that point there might be a way to work out all of these things you're talking about trying to do with your amendment. LB 536 would stay where it is on Final Reading if you took this to the Revenue Committee. Senator Wickersham had said if LB 536 were returned to the Revenue Committee, that committee would be gotten together and they would work that bill expeditiously.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And get it back here in time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's what he said. The A bill...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...could even be easier.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...if I had assurance of something like that, I...I would definitely entertain considering that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then, without trying to get a commitment from you, and it looks like we might leave this anyway at this point, we can talk about that and see if there's some way, maybe baby steps, step-by-step we can get some movement here.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So, since we're almost at the end of the
