CLERK: 18 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to invoke cloture.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Cloture is not successful. Debate for the day ends. We next move to the next item on the agenda, that is Final Reading. Members, please take your seats. Before we begin Final Reading, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. I have a motion from Senator Connealy regarding LB 75. Amendments to be printed: Senator Jensen to LB 640 and LB 640A; Senator Beutler, LB 142; Senator Raikes, LB 305A. I have confirmation reports from the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee, and from the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, signed by their respective Chairs. Senator Robak offers LR 255 and LR 256. Both will be laid over. I have a Reference report, Mr. President, referring LR 72 to the Natural Resources Committee for public hearing. And, Mr. President, I have an amendment to be printed by Senator Brashear and others to LB 851. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 2129-2135.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Members, would you please take your seats for Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, LB 23E.

CLERK: (Read LB 23 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 23, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 2135-2136.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 23, with the emergency clause attached, passes. LB 23AE.

CLERK: (Read LB 23A on Final Reading.)
