SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 433 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2165.) 28 ayes, 17 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 433 passes. LB 433A.

CLERK: (Read LB 433A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 433A pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 2165-2166.) 36 ayes, 7 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 443A passes. Items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports they've examined and engrossed LB 97 and find the same correctly engrossed. A series of amendments to be printed: Senator Beutler to LB 305; Senator Bromm, LB 389; Senator Bromm, LB 461; Senator Wehrbein, LB 536; and Senator Erdman to LB 852.
