SENATOR WICKERSHAM: ...to the underlying proposal from Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Senator Bruning, there are no further lights. Do you wish to close on your amendment, AM2163? Senator Bruning waives closing. The question before the body is AM2163 offered by Senator Bruning to the Chambers amendment, AM2141. All in favor of that vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bruning's amendment to the Chambers amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Bruning amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk. We're back to the Chambers amendment as amended. Senator Chambers. There are no lights on, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the amendment has been discussed. And I have nothing further to say on it at this point. I just hope you will vote to adopt it. It will then be before us as the bill, and any additional questions or observations people have, they'll be able to make them. This vote is not the final vote on the bill this evening. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, ...were you closing, Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: I forgot to ask you. The question before the body is the adoption of AM2141 offered by Senator Chambers. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Chambers amendment to LB 75, AM2141. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Chambers amendment, AM2141, is adopted. Open for discussion, E & R for engrossing. Senator Bruning.
