SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I have a little sticky note here that I've had on my lamp for some time from Senator Hilgert that says "call of the house". (Laughter) I believe I will take his advice and call the house and ask for a roll call vote...

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...in regular order.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. Senator Brashear, would you please check in. Senator Stuhr, would you please check in. Senator Jones. All present or accounted for, the question before the body is, shall cloture be invoked on LB 657? Mr. Clerk, call the roll in regular order.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 2260-2261.) 37 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to invoke cloture, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Next vote will be advancement of LB 657 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on advancement of LB 657 to E & R for engrossing. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk. Record vote has been requested.

CLERK: Senator, by who? By you, Senator Beutler?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, by you?
