CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is returned. Senator Wehrbein, you are recognized to open on AM2160 to LB 536.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. President. This is the amendment that I was discussing. I don't know if there is any more questions on it. Once again, I would like to thank those that participated. It's like many consensuses, not everyone is happy. I think it's as good as we could do considering the lateness of the session and all those kinds of things. It does put farmers' money in a first rate position in terms of the amount that is going to be used, if it, in fact, brings plants to Nebraska, which we hope it will do. The mod...very modest amount of General Funds and I would encourage your support. Thank you.
