And what my intent, in signing on as a cointroducer of this resolution was to recognize that and also encourage the identification of other restoration work that might need to be done and to provide some assurance that the Legislature plans to work with the executive branch in maintaining and improving and restoring this Capitol Building on behalf of all of the citizens of the state of Nebraska. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close. Senator Wickersham waives closing. The question is the adoption of LR 271. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of LR 271.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The resolution is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, right...at this point, I have a unanimous consent request, from Senator Suttle. She would move to...ask unanimous consent to withdraw LR 74.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Without objection? So ordered.
Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I then have a motion from Senator Kristensen. Senator Kristensen would move to withdraw LB 817, LB 818, LB 819, LB 820, LB 821 and LB 822.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, you're recognized on your motion.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, these bills represent the shell bills for redistricting that were introduced at the time of bill introduction. Because we had a change in rules and procedures this year, those bills were also introduced by the Redistricting Committee; those are the bills that we have voted on and passed. There's no need for these bills. They've not been set for
