CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 275.)
41 ayes, 3 nays to invoke cloture, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Cloture is invoked. The next vote is the pending matter of the Foley amendment. All those in favor of the Foley amendment vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

CLERK: 44 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Foley's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted. The next vote is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone malfunction)...roll call vote.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Senator Chambers has requested a roll call vote. This is on the vote of advancement of the bill. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 275-276.) 40 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 824.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 824 advances. I raise the call. Members, to give you some idea why we're getting ready to move on to the next bill, I would envision we're going to work through the noonhour. I've had a number of requests. I would guess somewhere in the neighborhood of 1:30, if that's...if that's the will of the body, I think that would be an appropriate time. Members, I'm going to change the agenda briefly this morning to allow for a rule suspension motion with regards to a hearing notice, and we're going to go to that right now.
