SENATOR ERDMAN: Okay. Piperidinocyclohexanecarbonitrile.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You left out the "a-n" part.

SENATOR ERDMAN: "Hexane", excuse me, yes, good point.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We are going to make that a wash. Would you turn to page 13. You ready?

SENATOR ERDMAN: Sure.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Line 1, the first word.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Any.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You got it. He passed. He's qualified to bring this bill. I'm going to support it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Anyone else wishing to discuss the advancement of LB 500? Seeing no lights on, Senator Erdman, do you wish to close? Senator Erdman waives closing. The question before the body is advancement of LB 500 to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on advancement of LB 500. Have you all voted who care to? Please vote if you care to. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 500.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 500 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 241 is a bill by Senator Price. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 5, referred to Health and Human Services, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM0330, Legislative Journal page 584, First Session, 2001.)
