SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, this is not on the bill. I'm not going to take long. I'm going to support moving the bill because I can do some additional work on it on Select File, so I want to be sure it gets there. But I was telling you some things from this letter and I'm going to hand it out, but since I said something for the record I want to give the whole statement that this preacher wrote. Quote: As in the western movies just before a criminal is about to die, the line says, see you in hell. One of my colleagues said doesn't that mean that the preacher is going to have to be there to see you there? Quite an astute observation.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on advancement? Seeing none, Senator Brashear, you're recognized to close on advancement.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I think you've all heard this is a...this is a bill that relates to the licensure of lawyers in enforcing compliance and checking criminal records. The bill has been made better by the two amendments by Senator Chambers and the amendment by Senator Beutler. I urge its advancement. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 848 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 848.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. We next move to LB 848A.

CLERK: LB 848A by Senator Brashear. (Read title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Brashear, you're recognized to open on the A bill.
