SENATOR BROMM: No, I...I'm not doubting that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...how does this hurt by putting in the statute and giving notice to judges, lawyers and people who want to be Attorney General what the state of the law is right now? What's wrong with giving the public that notice?

SENATOR BROMM: I think it sets a precedent that the Legislature is going to design the citation rather than letting the Supreme Court design the citation. I don't really think we need to get into that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, are you aware that under the statute right now where we gave the Supreme Court that authority the Legislature stated...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS ...specific things that are to be on the citation? We've...

SENATOR BROMM: I...

SENATOR BROMM: ...I read that in the bill, Senator Chambers. Yeah, there are some items there.
