CLERK: Senator Wickersham would move to amend the committee amendment, Mr. President. (AM2371, Legislative Journal page 306.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to open on that.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Mr. President, the amendment to the committee amendment simply changes a date that the auditor would be asked to submit a plan from 2002 to 2003.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment to the committee amendment? Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President, members of the body, Senator Wickersham, I didn't get into this until just a little bit ago. Is there still two auditors in this...going to be in the A bill?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: No, if...if the amendment to the amendment...the committee amendments are adopted, the A bill will go away.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the amendment to the committee amendments. Seeing none, Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Wickersham amendment to the committee amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to adopt Senator Wickersham's amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted. We're now back to debating the committee amendment. Seeing no debate, Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close on the adoption of that
