SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment? Senator Redfield, you're recognized to close. She waives that opportunity. The question before the body is the adoption of the Redfield amendment to LB 57. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, on the adoption of Senator Redfield's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: We're debating advancement of the bill. Senator Redfield, you're recognized to close on advancement. She waives that opportunity. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 57. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. Items for the record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. I have a series of notice of committee hearings offered by the Transportation Committee, the Revenue Committee, the Executive Board, Appropriations Committee, Urban Affairs Committee, and Health and Human Services Committee.
