include grain warehouses and a list of agricultural supply businesses. The primary substantive provisions are found in Sections 4 and 5, and what we've done now is introduce an amendment that will substitute the green copy...for the green copy of the bill, the...the areas that we needed to correct in order to make this more acceptable to those people. And Senator Beutler had filed a group of amendments to the bill. I think we've worked with him to come to an agreement on what the bill ought to do and I think that's roughly where we are, is waiting for the amendment to talk about the changes.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Dierks. Mr. Clerk, amendments on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have amendments to the bill. Senator Beutler, first of all, Senator, I have a series of amendments from you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Clerk, if you would, I would like to withdraw the pending amendment as well as all further amendments that I have filed to the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Dierks, the next amendment to the bill, Senator, AM2279. I have a note you want to withdraw that as well.

SENATOR DIERKS: Withdraw.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Dierks would move to amend with AM2487. (Legislative Journal pages 424-429.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Dierks, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature. This amendment incorporates a compromise that we have reached with Senator Beutler and the problems that he had with the bill, and I want to acknowledge at this point the cooperation that we received from Senator Beutler and his staff and his willingness to work with me and my staff. I think we both agree that this amendment has much improved the bill.
