CLERK: Mr. President, LB 435A, I have no amendments to the bill, Senator Erdman.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized for a motion.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I move the advancement of LB 435A to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion, that is to advance the bill. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It is advanced. We next move to General File. We resume debate on LB 95. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 95 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Schimek. (Read title.) Bill was discussed yesterday, Mr. President. The committee amendments were offered by the Transportation Committee. When the Legislature adjourned for the day, Senator Chambers had pending, and I believe had offered, amendment...FA830 to the committee amendments. Senator is that...okay. (Legislative Journal page 401.)

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, is this like an opening or what am I doing?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You're giving me an update, Senator, before we start debate on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. And that...so I'm going to keep it very brief. On page...in line 5, because there's only one page to the committee amendment, it's a half page, I would begin with the word "as" and strike through the second "and" in line 6. What this relates to is the language in the bill, the committee amendment which would become the bill, that is talking about a definition of a limousine which provides these special services. What those words mean will not be found in the bill itself. The bill will say, as those words are defined by the rules and regulations of the Public Service Commission. I do not believe
