were an amendment by Senator Wickersham, an amendment by Senator Chambers that were adopted. When the Legislature adjourned for the day I believe Senator Chambers had pending FA832. Senator, it's page 1, line 15, after "alter" (sic--"utero") insert "or in vitro". (Legislative Journal page 449.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, I believe you opened on that. Well, why don't you just give us a brief rundown of what the amendment does, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, and I would like the Clerk to listen, I'm going to withdraw that amendment and have it placed at the bottom of the list.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Foley, I'm now back to your amendment, Senator. Senator Foley, this is the amendment you put...

SENATOR FOLEY: Can we pass that over and stick it at the bottom?

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is passed over.

CLERK: Senator Schimek would move to amend, FA833. (Legislative Journal page 452.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek, you're recognized to open on FA833 to LB 824.

CLERK: This is the amendment you gave me last Thursday, Senator, handwritten, if you recall.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Amendment FA833.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: My problem is I'm trying to find the amendment AM2336, but I can work off another one here I think. Oh, I've got it. Thank you very much. This...this would, beginning on line 4 of Section 5, strike the "(a)" in there, and then beginning on line 8 you'd insert a period after "pregnancy", and
