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commission, and it removes the district court judge from membership of the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice and the Jail Standards Board, and this is being done with regard to the concern over judicial, executive, and legislative responsibilities and charges under the constitution and trying not to mix the functions of the different branches of government. That is Senator Bourne's bill, and I believe he will maybe want to speak to it. He also has a small amendment to it. And then, finally, LB 930, which is the most...the longest part of the amendment and I want to tell you a little bit about how these boards and commissions were added into the bill. We did do extensive, extensive research on these different boards and commissions and then some of those that we identified we asked Legislative Research to do some more follow-up on, and they came back with their information and their appraisals of these different boards and commissions. And we finally got down to this list of, oh, I think it was maybe 17, but at the behest of the Governor's Office we actually added in a couple of other boards and commissions. We had the hearing on the bill. There were only two that actually anybody came in on, and one of them was, trying to find it here, the Chronic Renal Disease Program Advisory Committee, as I recall, and there was nobody actually from that committee who came in. It was a lobbyist who came in on it. And then I am going to have to ask staff to remind me of which the other one was. Which was the other one that they came in on, do you remember, Christine? Was that the radiation? Oh, the Nurse Anesthetists and the Radiation Advisory Council were the others. So with that, I think this is a good bill. I think that it's good that...or a good amendment. It's good that we go through these different boards and commissions on a periodic basis and, with that, I would be happy to try to answer questions. Thank you.
