February 5, 2002 LB 259, 830

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 830 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the advancement of LB 830. All in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It advances. LB 259.

CLERK: LB 259, first of all, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, Senator. (AM7144, Legislative Journal page 356.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized for a motion to adopt those amendments.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 259.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein would move to amend with AM2558. (Legislative Journal pages 493-494.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Speaker, members of the body, this is an amendment that, pursuant to what happened on General File with the vote of county citizens, as far as having the occupation tax take effect, this is the language that comes from the cities and towns language, where they need to have a...a vote of the people. This, then, is for the county board. It's an additional section that mandates that the county board shall submit the question of imposing a license or tax under Section 1 of this to the registered voters. And it outlines the procedure that they should go through in order to have this tax. It's per Senator Chambers' amendment on...on the...on General File. This
