I think it meets the expectations of the body in this case, and I would urge the adoption of this amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I waive closing, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, he waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Wehrbein amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Erdman, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 259 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the advancement of LB 259. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It advances. LB 482.

CLERK: LB 482, Senator, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all. (AM7147, Legislative Journal page 360.)
