SENATOR ERDMAN: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 482.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Hartnett would move to amend with AM2420. (Legislative Journal page 414.)

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, this amendment was brought to me by the...by the Bill Drafters. And there's some...some changes in the bill that needed to be made, and it deals with the basic phrase, wrestling, boxing, or sparring matches, or exhibitions and applies uniformly throughout the bill, (inaudible) the bill was originally drafted did not apply uniformly throughout the bill. The amendment only harmonizes use of these terms. As I said, was recommended by all...by the Revisor's Office. And this amendment will...will ensure that no confusion and meaning about this bill so there's no question. I'd simply ask for the adoption of this amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the opening on the amendment. Further debate on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Hartnett, you're recognized to close. He waives the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Hartnett amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. We're voting on the Hartnett amendment. Members, please vote if you care to. Record.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.
