SENATOR VRTISKA: Withdraw.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: It's withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, then, pursuant to rule, Senator Janssen, as primary introducer, has two amendments. Senator, I have FA111 that was filed last year, but again I understand you want to withdraw that.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I want to withdraw that and substitute AM2560, please.

CLERK: Well, Senator, we can withdraw because AM2560 would be next.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. Fine.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Janssen would move to amend with AM2560. (Legislative Journal page 499.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Janssen, you're recognized to open on that amendment.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. AM2560, on page 1, strike line 2 and insert...in line 2, and insert the amount of "five" cents, and then, in line 13, after "equipment",
