SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Pederson. Senator Brashear. The question has been called. Senator Brashear, there are no further lights on so that won't be necessary. Thank you. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close on the amendments.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I think there's been enough discussion. I will ask you adopt...to adopt this amendment because what it does is replace everything in the bill that related to judges not having to be lawyers. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on AM2443. Question before the body is adoption of AM2443. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of AM2443 to LB 752. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone malfunction) I will ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.
