FLOOR DEBATE

February 8, 2002 LB 752

Chambers has allowed call-in votes. Senator Connealy, would you check in, please? Senator Jones, Senator Synowiecki, the house is under call. All unexcused senators please report to the Chamber.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Wickersham voting yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Chambers amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: AM2443 was adopted. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next item I have is a motion to indefinitely postpone by Senator Bruning, but I have a note that he wishes to withdraw that motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: That motion is withdrawn.

ASSISTANT CLERK: I have nothing further pending on the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to advancing LB 752, bill itself. Open for discussion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Chambers, did you wish to close on advancement of LB 752?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, there has been an extensive discussion. What is before us now is the original amendment I had offered as amended by Senators Beutler, myself, and Senator Bruning. I hope you will vote to advance this bill and I'm going to ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.
