SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the advancement? Senator Jensen, you are recognized to close on advancement.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. First of all, I want to thank everyone for their participation in this. Yes, it is a different approach, it's new. I think it is an approach that will work for the schools, that's what we really are attempting to do here. And I...I think that we have answered many of the questions. If there's still more out there, between now and Select File, Senator Quandahl, myself, would be more than happy to answer those questions. And we want you to have a good comfort feeling with this. I hope that we can provide that. With that I would just ask for the advancement of LB 391.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. I heard a request, Senator Suttle, you've asked for a record vote. Have you all voted? We're voting on advancement. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 596-597.) The vote is 33 ayes, 0 nays, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. (Visitors introduced.) We next move to LB 185.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 185, a bill originally introduced by Senator Don Pederson and others. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 4 of last year. At that time it was referred to the Business and Labor Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File, I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM0789, Legislative Journal page 958, First Session, 2001.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Pederson, you're recognized to open on the bill.
