SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Call the question, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on ceasing debate. Have you all voted who care to? We are voting on ceasing debate. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Debate does cease. Senator Pederson, for what purpose did you rise?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: I would like to ask for a call of the house and a record vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a call of the house. Senator Pederson, your time will start running because you are recognized to close. Been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Pederson, you are recognized to close.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Mr. President, I'd like to also note that the General Affairs Committee, I understand, is meeting. There they are. They're coming in now, so...okay, if I may begin, as I said, I've said this several times, this is a very simple bill.
