SENATOR D. PEDERSON: For a roll call vote, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: A request, by Senator Pederson, for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 642-643.) 19 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 185 does not advance. I do raise the call. Did you have any items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Your Committee on Health and Human Services reports LB 1033 to General File with committee amendments attached. And Government reports LB 1031 to General File; LB 1018, General File with amendments; LB 1233 indefinitely postponed. Senator Brown, an amendment to LB 935 to be printed. And new A bills: LB 877A by Senator Smith. (Read by title for the first time.) LB 1195A by Senator Bromm. (Read by title for the first time.) And a priority bill designation by the Banking Committee, LB 957. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 643-646.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next item, LR 6 proposes a constitutional amendment to Article III, Section 24, of the Nebraska Constitution. The resolution was originally introduced by Senator Schimek. It was referred to the General Affairs Committee for public hearing. Resolution was advanced to General File, Mr. President. I do have motions pending to the bill, Mr. President.
