SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain this morning is Pastor Matt Geiger from the First Christian (sic) Congregational Church in Lincoln, guest of Senator Don Pederson.

Transportation Committee, chaired by Senator Bromm, reports LB 1228 to General File, Mr. President.

In addition to those items, the Transportation Committee has selected LB 1081 and LB 1105 as their priority bills. Senator Coordsen, an amendment to LB 58 to be printed.
