Whenever there is an activity which is deemed to be so nefarious, "Duchess", that those under 18 years old or whatever it is cannot participate, that cannot be an activity which is of suitable moral rectitude to be used by a church to raise money for anything. But the Catholics manage to do it. Now somebody stand on this floor and tell me that what I've said about that is vile, and I'll tell you that you are crazy. But I'm going to tell my good friend in front of me, whose back is to me, something that I heard in the nature of a rumor. Now you all have read that the Pope has conducted some exorcisms during his term. I was told, Senator Maxwell, that the Catholic League has put together a group of brigands who are going to kidnap me, spirit me to the Vatican and have the Pope perform a personal exorcism on me to exorcise out of me whatever it is that makes me what I am. I kind of look forward to it. (Laughter) I would know how to deal with that because I saw the movie "The Exorcist". I've been practicing making my head spin all the way around, and I'm not going to do it on the floor because my colleagues already think that I have too much affinity with the devil.
